Subject:	Septic Hauler Agreement for the Residuals Dewatering (Biosolids) Facility

#### BACKGROUND

On May 2, 2017, the Indian River County (IRC) Board of County Commissioners (BCC) directed staff in the Indian River County Department of Utility Services (IRCDUS) to work with the County Attorney's office to create an agreement similar to the one in use by Brevard County that can be tailored for use by IRC haulers who use the Residuals Dewatering Facility (RDF).

### ANALYSIS:

Per BCC direction in the May 2, 2017, meeting, the RDF immediately ceased accepting out-of-county waste from non-Indian River county haulers and will no longer accept any out-of-county waste from Indian River county haulers beginning June 1, 2017. This is the first step in bringing the West Regional Wastewater Treatment Facility (WWTF) into permit compliance. Based on hauler logs submitted in April 2017, two-thirds of the intake at the RDF were from sources outside Indian River County, and the associated loads are inhibiting the ability of the West Regional WWTF to process within the parameters of its permit.

Implementing the attached application and agreement will ensure that all Indian River County haulers going forward will know the conditions for using the RDF, and the consequences for bringing anything that would cause an upset or bypass event at the West Regional WWTF. The proposed fine structure is as follows:
