

GENERAL NOTE

THE "WORK", AS DEFINED IN THE DRAWINGS AND THE TECHNICAL AND NON-TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS INCLUDES BUT IS NOT NECESSARILY LIMITED TO THE FOLLOWING:

- LIMITED DEMOLITION WORK**
DEMOLITION FOR THE EXISTING LD PIER,
INCLUDING FRAMING REPAIR, DECKING REPLACEMENT, NEW
RAILINGS, POLE MOUNTED LIGHTING AND FIRE PROTECTION
 - 2) ALTERNATE #1:**
REPLACEMENT OF SYNTHETIC DECKING IN LIEU OF WOOD DECKING
FOR THE REPLACEMENT DOCKING AT THE EXISTING PIER
 - 3) ALTERNATE #2:**
PROVIDE NEW PILES AND SUPPORT FRAMING FOR THE ICE
HOUSE
 - 4) ALTERNATE #3:**
PROVIDE ALL WORK REQUIRED TO FURNISH AND INSTALL
THE COMPLETE WOOD DECK AT THE EAST SIDE OF THE
FISH HOUSE INCLUDING PILES, FRAMING, DECKING, LIGHTING
AND RAILINGS. PROVIDE SEPARATE PRICES FOR BOTH
WOOD AND SYNTHETIC DECKING.
 - 5) ALTERNATE #4:**
PROVIDE ALL WORK REQUIRED TO FURNISH AND INSTALL
THE COMPLETE WOOD RAMPS AND LANDINGS INCLUDING
PILES, FRAMING, DECKING, RAILINGS AND HANDRAILS AS
WELL AS THE FOLLOWING DOCK WITH VARIABLE RAAMP
PROVIDE SEPARATE PRICES FOR BOTH WOOD AND
SYNTHETIC DECKING.
 - 6) ALTERNATE #5:**
PROVIDE ALL WORK REQUIRED TO FURNISH AND INSTALL THE
COMPLETE WOOD SWIVEL BOAT DOCK INCLUDING PILES,
FRAMING, DECKING, RAILINGS CLEATS AND DOCK BUMPERs.
PROVIDE SEPARATE PRICES FOR BOTH WOOD AND
SYNTHETIC DECKING.

CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITY

1. ALL WORK TO COMPLY WITH APPLICABLE CODES. THE CONTRACTOR MUST COMPLY WITH THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE STATE, LOCAL, AND FEDERAL GOVERNMENT AND TO CONFORM TO ALL CITY, COUNTY, STATE AND FEDERAL CONSTRUCTION, SAFETY AND SANITARY LAWS, CODES, STATUTES AND ORDINANCES.

2. ALL FEES, TAXES, PERMIT APPLICATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION AND THE FILING OF ALL WORK WITH GOVERNMENTAL AGENCIES TO BE THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE CONTRACTOR. CONTRACTOR TO OBTAIN ALL PERMITS AND APPROVALS FROM THE GOVERNMENT WITH THE WORK.

3. ALL WORK SHALL BE PERFORMED BY SKILLED AND QUALIFIED WORKERS IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE BEST PROFESSIONAL PRACTICES AND IN CONFORMANCE WITH BUILDING REGULATIONS AND/OR GOVERNMENT LAWS, STATUTES OR ORDINANCES CONCERNING THE USE OF UNION LABOR.

4. THE CONTRACTOR AND SUB-CONTRACTORS TO HEED VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND CONDITIONS SHOWN ON DOCUMENTS AND MUST NOTIFY ARCHITECT OF ANY DISCREPANCIES, OPINIONS AND/OR CONFLICTS PRIOR TO PROCEEDING WITH THE WORK.

5. EACH TRADE WILL BE EXPECTED TO PROCEED IN A FASHION THAT WILL NOT DELAY OTHER TRADES.

6. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF DRAWINGS TO ALL TRADES UNDER THEIR JURISDICTION.

7. ALL MATERIALS TO BE USED, UNLESS NOTED OR IF THE HIGHEST QUALITY MATERIAL IS NOT UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED, MANUFACTURED MATERIALS TO BE USED, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED AND INSTALLED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE MANUFACTURER'S WRITTEN RECOMMENDATIONS AND INSTRUCTIONS.

8. WHERE A MANUFACTURER IS SPECIFIED AND EQUAL TO, OTHER EQUIVALENT EQUIPMENT ARE USED, ARCHITECT/ENGINEER TO DETERMINE EQUALITY BASED ON INFORMATION SUBMITTED BY THE CONTRACTOR.

1. ALL USED AND MATERIALS TO BE GUARANTEED AGAINST DEFECTS FOR PERIOD OF ONE (1) YEAR FROM THE DATE OF APPROVAL OF FINAL PAYMENT. FOR EQUIPMENT, PLUMBING, ELECTRICAL, AND MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT, INFORMATION TO OWNER UPON PROJECT COMPLETION.

16. THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR CUTTING AND PATCHING REQUIRED FOR HIS WORK UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED.

17. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL AT ALL TIMES KEEP THE WORK AREA FREE OF ACACIA STICKS, BRANCHES, AND MATERIALS & PUSHERS PROVIDED BY THE OWNER, CLEAN AND NEAT.

18. THE CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE FINAL CLEANING OF ALL AREAS OF BORR INCLUDING THE CONSTRUCTION ACCESS ROUTE.

19. DO NOT SCALE DRAWINGS DIMENSIONS GOVERN LARGEST SCALE DRAWINGS TO GOVERN OVER SMALLER SCALE DRAWINGS.

20. OPERATIONS AS IN QUESTION, THE CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE TO GET CLARIFICATION AND DIRECTION FROM ARCHITECT PRIOR TO PROCEEDING WITH THE WORK.

21. ALL INSTALLED PLUMBING AND ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT TO OPERATE QUIETLY AND BE FREE OF VIBRATION.

22. UPON COMPLETION OF THE WORK, THE CONTRACTOR TO NOTIFY BUILDING OWNERS REPRESENTATIVE THAT THE PROJECT IS COMPLETE AND THAT THE OWNER WILL COMPILE A "PUNCH LIST" OF CORRECTIONS NEEDED, OR UNSATISFACTORY AND/OR INCOMPLETE WORK. FINAL PAYMENT TO CONTRACTOR TO BE MADE UPON THE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE PUNCH LIST.

23. ALL WORK TO BE SCHEDULED DURING REGULAR BUSINESS HOURS UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE.

24. ALL WORK SHALL BE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE 2014 EDITION AND RELATED SUPPLEMENTS, OF THE (IRC) INTERNATIONAL RESIDENTIAL CODE AS ADOPTED BY LOCAL REGULATIONS.


25. VERIFY ALL DIMENSIONS AND SITE CONDITIONS PRIOR THE START OF CONSTRUCTION. NOTIFY THE

ARCHITECT/ENGINEER OF ANY DISCREPANCIES OR INCONSISTENCIES PRIOR TO BID.

20. DESIGN INFORMATION SHOWN ON THE DRAWINGS PROVIDE OVERALL DIMENSIONS, PARAMETERS AND DESCRIBE CONSTRUCTION REQUIREMENTS. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL ADJUST DIMENSIONS AND DETAILS AS REQUIRED TO FIT EXISTING CONDITIONS. THE ARCHITECT/ENGINEER SHALL BE NOTIFIED OF ANY PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION.
 21. IF REQUIRED, DEMOLITION SHALL INCLUDE RECYCLING, TRANSPORT, AND DISPOSAL OF ALL WASTE MATERIAL RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION. THE CONTRACTOR SHALL FOLLOW THE APPROPRIATE PROCEDURES FOR THE FACILITY IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPLICABLE STATES' ORDINANCES, AND POLICIES.
 22. AT START OF CONSTRUCTION, THE CONTRACTOR SHALL SECURE ONE FULL SIZE SET OF THE FINAL CONSTRUCTION / PERIODIC CONSTRUCTION DOCUMENTS TO BE MAINTAINED IN A CLEAN AND DRY PLACE.
 23. CONTRACTOR IS RESPONSIBLE FOR KEEPING CONSTRUCTION AREA CLEAN AND FREE FROM DEBRIS ON A DAILY BASIS. ALL DEBRIS SHALL BE REMOVED AND DISPOSED OF IN A LOCAL / APPROVED DISPOSAL REQUIREMENTS.
 24. CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE ALL METAL CONNECTIONS TO PREVENT ELECTROLYTIC / CORROSION OF DISMANTLED METALS. STAINLESS STEEL CONNECTIONS WITH METAL FLANGE ARE ALLOWED. CONTRACTOR TO PROVIDE ALL CONNECTIONS TO PREVENT STAINLESS STEEL FROM BECOMING ACTIVE. WHEN USING GALVANIZED CONNECTIONS, PROVIDE GALVANIZED CONNECTIONS TO PREVENT ELECTROLYTIC CORROSION. UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE, PROVIDE ALL E-BOLTED NUT TO BOLT CONNECTIONS WITH A SYNTHETIC RUBBER COATING AT THE POINT OF CONTACT FOR ALL CONNECTIONS OR PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION COMPLETION.
