DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS

Indian River County applied for and received a Small County Outreach Program (SCOP) Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in the amount of \$1,946,618.00 for the reconstructing of 58th Avenue from north of 57th Street to 85th Street/CR510, as well as for construction engineering inspection (CEI) services (estimated total cost for the project is \$4,073,870.00). The proposed improvements to 58th Avenue from north of 57th Street to 85th Street/CR510 consist of reconstructing the roadway utilizing full depth reclamation, milling and resurfacing, widening the existing shoulders to 5-feet, structural asphalt, surface asphalt, drainage improvements, waterline directional bore, utility adjustments, signing, and pavement markings. The County's portion is estimated to be \$2,127,252.00.

FUNDING

Funding for the County's cost share in the amount of \$2,127,252.00 will be funded by Account Number 10921441-053360-16023 Secondary Roads/FDOT SCOP Grant/58th Avenue Resurfacing-57th Street to CR510.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Board approve the FDOT SCOP Agreement (FM No. 436416-1-54-01) and Resolution and authorize the Chairman to execute the same.
