SUBJECT: Legal Services – Labor & Employment Matters

### **BACKGROUND**

Indian River County Board of County Commissioners has been represented in labor and employment matters by Fisher & Phillips, LLP for many years. The services provided are specialized and require a high degree of expertise. Staff is well satisfied with the service provided by Fisher & Phillips. Effective October 1, 2018, the hourly rate for attorneys for services provided by Fisher & Phillips will increase from \$265 to \$280.

### **FUNDING:**

The remittance to Fisher & Phillips in FY2016/17 was \$24,062.00 for legal services. Funding for legal services is included in the current budget and is also budgeted in the upcoming FY2018/19 budget. Expenses are dependent upon the number and complexity of legal issues that require representation. The increase in hourly attorney's fees represents a 5.7% increase.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff respectfully recommends the Board of County Commissioners authorize the continuation of the engagement agreement with Fisher & Phillips to provide legal services for labor and employment matters.
