SUBJECT:

Treasure Coast Tri-County 2019 State Legislative Priorities

<u>Background:</u> On November 26, 2018, the Indian River County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") met with the Martin County Board of County Commissioners and the St. Lucie County Board of County Commissioners pursuant to Section 125.001, Florida Statutes. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss a number of legislative issues that impact the Treasure Coast. Subsequently, staff worked with the Legislative Coordinator for Martin County and the Legislative Director for St. Lucie County to draft the attached Treasure Coast Tri-County Legislative Priorities list. This list will assist the County Attorney's Office, the County Administrator, and the County's contract lobbyists during the 2019 State of Florida legislative session which is scheduled to begin on March 5, 2018.

Recommendation: The County Attorney's Office recommends that the Board adopt the attached Treasure Coast Tri-County 2019 State Legislative Priorities.
