2019 State Legislative List of Priorities and Concerns

<u>Background</u>: On September 18, 2018, the Indian River County Board of County Commissioners ("Board") approved a 2019 Pre-Session Legislative List of Priorities and Concerns. The referenced presession list needs to be amended to include new policy statements on a number of topics that impact local governments. It also needs to be amended to include the County's appropriation requests. These amendments will assist the County Attorney's Office, the County Administrator, and the County's contract lobbyists during the 2019 State of Florida legislative session which is scheduled to begin on March 5, 2018.
