DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS

To compliment improvement efforts currently underway at the Jackie Robinson Training Complex (FKA Historic Dodgertown) being completed under the County's lease agreement with Major League Baseball (MLB), County Staff was tasked with requesting a proposal from MBV Engineering, Inc. for an interconnected walking trail that would improve accessibility within the Complex, and provide a pedestrian connection to 43rd Avenue and Aviation Boulevard. The proposed walking trail will include a pedestrian bridge connection to the cloverleaf fields and a new tree line buffer along 43rd Avenue.

On April 17, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Continuing Consulting Engineering Service Agreement for Professional Services with MBV Engineering, Inc. The purpose of Work Order No. 10 is to provide design services, including permitting, bidding, and construction administration for an interconnected walking trail at the Complex for a lump sum amount of \$39,000.00. MBV Engineering, Inc. has provided a preliminary estimated construction cost for the walking trail of \$591,223.05.

FUNDING

Funding of \$39,000 will be provided by a budget amendment from Optional Sales Tax/Cash Forward.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of Work Order No. 10 with MBV Engineering, Inc. authorizing the professional services as outlined in the Scope of Work and authorize the Chairman to execute Work Order No. 10 on their behalf for a lump sum amount of \$39,000.00.
