Subject: Work Order No. 17 for Kimley-Horn
58th Avenue Utility Relocations – 53rd Street to 57th Street

Background:

In conjunction with roadway improvements to 58th Avenue required to be constructed by Waterway Village, Indian River County Public Works is proposing the replacement of the bridge over the North Relief Canal. The project will impact existing Indian River County Department of Utility Services (IRCDUS) water and sewer utilities. IRCDUS has therefore decided to hire Kimley-Horn to prepare a utility relocation design.

Analysis:

On April 17, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) approved the Continuing Contract Agreement for Professional Services with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. In accordance with that agreement, Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. will provide professional services to prepare Engineering Design Plans and Specifications.

Funding:

Funds for the project will be derived from the 58th Avenue Utility Relocations account in the Operating Fund. Operating funds are derived from water and sewer sales.
