Public Hearing: Modification to County Code Sections 201.64 and 201.65 (Legislative)

Vincent Burke, Director of Utility Services, provided the rationale for the request to prohibit discharge of hazardous waste pharmaceuticals from healthcare facilities and reverse distributors.

Chairman Adams opened the Public Hearing. There being no comments or discussion, the Chairman closed the Public Hearing.

A motion was made by Vice Chairman Flescher, seconded by Commissioner O'Bryan, to: 1) Approve staff's recommendation, and 2) Adopt Ordinance 2020-006, amending Sections 201.64 (Definitions; construction and interpretation) and 201.65 (Prohibited discharge standards) of Part III (the Indian River County Industrial Pretreatment Regulations Ordinance) of Chapter 201 (County Water and Sewer Services) of the Code of Indian River County, Florida establishing the prohibition of the discharge of hazardous waste pharmaceuticals from healthcare facilities and reverse distributors; and providing for codification, severability, repeal of conflicting provisions, and an effective date.
