DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS

Arcadis US, Inc., signed an agreement on May 17, 2005 with Indian River County to provide Civil Engineering and Land Surveying Services for improvements to the SR- $60/43^{rd}$ Avenue Intersection and the widening of 43^{rd} Avenue from 18^{th} Street to 26^{th} Street. Final design has been completed and the Florida Department of Transportation has informed the County that the Department will certify the right-of-way at the end of January 2019 .

On April 17, 2018, the Board of County Commissioners approved the Continuing Consulting Engineering Service Agreement for Professional Services with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc.

The purpose of Work Order No. 6 is for Kimley-Horn to provide final construction plan review services for the SR-60 & 43rd Avenue widening and intersection improvement project. Due to the magnitude of the project and in an effort to reduce potential costly construction issues and/or delays staff is of the opinion that this review will be a benefit to the County. Work Order No. 6 is for a total lump sum amount of \$35,000.

Staff anticipates advertising the project for bid in April/May 2019 with construction to commence in August/September of 2019.

FUNDING

Funding is budgeted and available in Optional Sales Tax/Account No. 31521441-066510-06041/43rd Avenue – 18th Street to 26th Street in the amount of \$35,000.00.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends approval of Work Order No. 6 to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc., authorizing the professional services as outlined in the Scope of Work and requests the Board authorize the Chairman to execute Work Order No. 6 on their behalf for a lump sum amount of \$35,000.00.
