DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS

Indian River County applied for and received a Small County Outreach Program (SCOP) Grant from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) in the amount of \$1,061,672 for the Construction and Construction Engineering Inspection (CEI) Services for milling and resurfacing 6th Avenue from SR-5/US 1 to 21st Street (estimated total cost for the project is \$2,039,152). The proposed improvements will include milling, resurfacing and pavement markings, along with drainage improvements. The County's portion is estimated to be \$977,480.

FUNDING

Per the SCOP grant agreement, the County must fund the project and then request reimbursement of the grant share from FDOT to a maximum amount of \$1,061,672 of the total cost for the project. Funding for the County's cost share in the amount of \$977,480 of the estimated cost is budgeted in Account No. 10921441-053360-19008/Secondary Roads/6TH Avenue Resurfacing US1 to 21st Street.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Board of County Commissioners approve the Small County Outreach Program (SCOP) Agreement and Resolution and authorize the Chairman to execute the same.
