SUBJECT: Renewal of RFP 2019060 FEMA Public Assistance Consulting Services

DESCRIPTION AND CONDITIONS

On September 10, 2019, the Board ratified the FEMA Public Assistance Consulting Services Agreement with Witt O'Brien's, which had been executed by the County Administrator on August 29, 2019, under authority granted by Resolution 2019-058. On August 18, 2020 the Board approved the first one-year extension of this contract.

ANALYSIS

The current agreement will expire on August 28, 2021. Witt O'Brien's has satisfactorily performed the consulting services as detailed in the agreement for the first extension of the contract.

FUNDING

Expenses incurred for work under this agreement are anticipated to be funded through FEMA's reimbursement of direct administrative costs.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends the Board approve the renewal of the agreement through August 28, 2022, for the second and final term of the available one-year renewal terms, and authorize the Chairman to execute the renewal after approval by the County Attorney as to form and legal sufficiency.
