**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW SIDEWALK ALONG 28<sup>th</sup> COURT AND 49TH STREET FOR THE 2026 TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) APPLICATION FOR THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT)**

**WHEREAS**, the sidewalk construction along 28th Court from 47th Street to 49th Street and along 49th Street from 28th Court to Old Dixie Highway is an Indian River County priority project; and

**WHEREAS**, the 28th Court/49th Street sidewalk project is identified as a high priority project in the Gifford Neighborhood Plan and the Indian River County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the Indian River County Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Board included this project on its List of Priority Projects (LOPP) the for the Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP); and

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Transportation has requested Indian River County submit this Resolution of Support for the 2026 TAP application to the Florida Department of Transportation; and

**WHEREAS**, the improvements of the project are located within Indian River County right-of-way of 28th Court and 49th Street.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF INDIAN RIVER COUNTY, FLORIDA**, that the Chairman of the Board is hereby authorized to sign and submit to the State of Florida, Department of Transportation, a Resolution of Support for the 28th Court/49th Street sidewalk project. The maintenance of said sidewalk will be maintained by the Indian River County once completed.
