BACKGROUND:

On October 9, 2024, Hurricane Milton made landfall as a Category 3 storm along Florida's Gulf coast near Siesta Key. Hurricane Milton caused an estimated \$3.8 million in damages to Indian River County BOCC.

In order to receive Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) reimbursement, Indian River County is required to sign the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement. The agreement is standard for all recipients.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends that the Board approve and authorize the Chairman to execute the agreement and all other documents necessary to effectuate the agreement and authorize the County Administrator to sign any additional modifications.
